What is it?

An International Competition celebrating the making of set model boxes from shoeboxes and other found materials.

Who can enter?

There are two main categories:

1. Outstanding Model Box- Create a model box for a play, novel, devised piece, film or poem of your choice.
2. Outstanding Bloomsbury Lit in Colour Model Box- Create a set model box for one of the following plays:
 - *Barbershop Chronicles* by Inua Ellams
 - *The Empress* by Tanika Gupta
 - *Refugee Boy* adapted for the stage by Lemn Sissay
 - *The Great Wave* by Francis Turnly
 - *Elmina's Kitchen* by Kwame Kwei-Armah
 - *The Convert* by Danai Gurira
 - *Gone Too Far!* by Bola Agbaje
 - *A Doll's House* adapted by Tanika Gupta
 - *Antigone* adapted by Roy Williams
 - *The Free9* by In-Sook Chappell

What do I have to do?

Work with your class, teacher or on your own to create your own individual model box, made from found materials. You can choose any stage space (End On, Thrust, Traverse or Theatre-in-the-round).

How will it be judged?

Each design will be judged on creativity and the effectiveness of the design concept. It will be judged by professional set designers and panel members from Bloomsbury Publishing.
